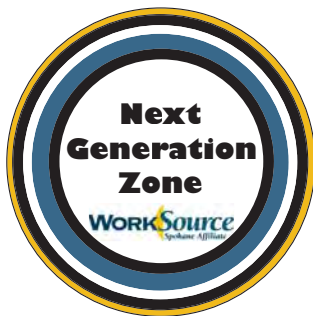

YouthBuild Spokane

YouthBuild engages low-income young adults ages 18-24, in earning a diploma or GED and overcoming barriers. Members serve their communities by building affordable housing for low-income families.

Institute for Extended Learning - GED Classes

GED (general educational development) tests help individuals who did not graduate earn a high school equivalency diploma.

Why is it important? Your GED will open doors - to college, training programs, the military, better jobs, and career advancement. It's the first step to building a better future.

The staff in our classroom work with 16-21 year olds, giving them one-on-one instruction to accomplish this goal.

Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Program

Our goal is to assist the next generation in reaching their educational and career goals. Participants must meet certain qualifications, such as being 16-21 and low-income to enroll in the program, but all are welcome to attend our workshops. The topics range from resume writing, to how to get & keep a job, to help with filling out financial aid forms. Motivated young adults should begin by attending one of our Information Sessions. Tincan - World of JobCraft

World of JobCraft is a program that helps 18-25 year olds gain education and skills to obtain a living wage job. Players earn points by attending hands-on workshops, industry tours, job shadows, and through game activities.

As they level up in the game they will get rewards such as gas cards and bus passes. To win the game the player either gets a living wage job, or starts an educational track towards a career. Sign up and start playing!
